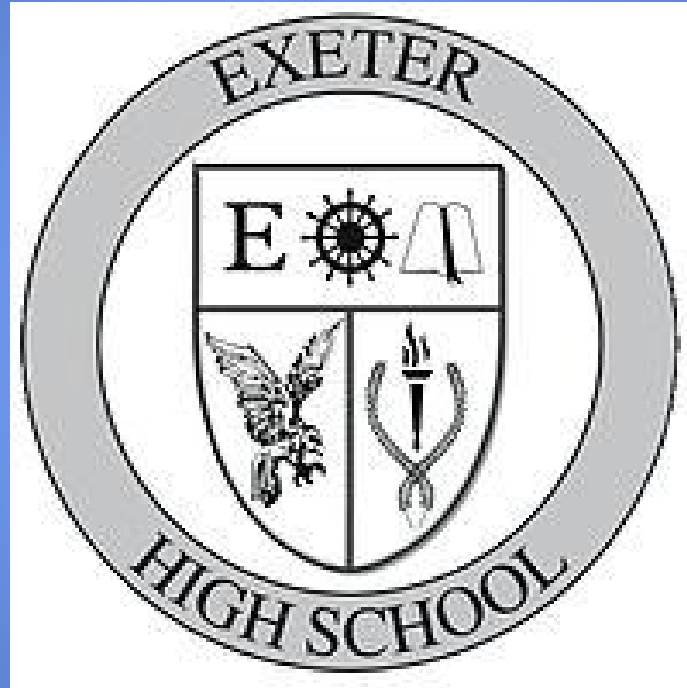

How do I graduate?



- It's simple: Come to school, do your work, follow the rules!
- When you pass a class (60 or higher) you receive CREDIT.
 - Half year classes = 2 credits
 - Full year classes = 4 credit
- You will need 80 Credits to earn a Diploma



What is course registration?

- Course registration is where you pick the level of your core courses based on recommendations from your current teachers
- Recommendations are based on academic performance, standardized test scores and work ethic

Course Registration Process

- Log into your PowerSchool Account.
- Click on the Class Registration Icon. The icon shows a yellow pencil and a yellow chair, with the text "Class Registration" to its right.
- You will see a list of Required courses and Electives.
- Requirements have a **RED** exclamation point next to the pencil.
- Electives have a **GREEN** exclamation point next to the pencil.
- Click on the pencil and choose the course your teacher recommended you for.
- Teacher recommendations appear in the ALERT Column.
- If you don't select a required course or the minimum credits required the system will not let you submit your selections.

Grade 9 Social Studies (Required)

You must successfully complete three years of Social Studies classes for graduation.

Grade 9 Mathematics (Required)

You must successfully complete a minimum of three years of Mathematics classes (including Algebra I) for graduation. Most colleges expect Mathematics through Algebra II.

Grade 9 Science (Required)

In order to graduate from Exeter High School, students must successfully complete a year of Physical Science and a year of Biology. Most colleges expect three years of Science including Biology, Chemistry and Physics.
