

PINNACLE 2019 SENIOR PORTRAIT & PERSONALITY PHOTO DUE NO LATER THAN **FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 28, 2018**

Beginning July 1, portraits and personality photos must be submitted through www.Replayit.com, a free service that allows you to upload your portraits and send them directly to the website we use to create the yearbook. Photographs are taken on your own using the photographer of your choice.

- Go to **Replayit.com**
- Register to create an account
- Click on “**Submit Pics**” (Your photos will not be visible online.)
- Follow instructions – making sure to choose **Student Life** category from the dropdown menu.
- When prompted, **tag the photo** with the student’s first and last name and indicate whether it is a Senior portrait or Senior personality photo. For example: Jane Doe – Personality.
- You must click “**Finished Tagging**” when form is complete.

All photos should be high quality digital images and should be shot vertically not horizontally as we will have to crop the photo to fit in the photo box. If the resolution is too low, Replayit will not allow you to upload your photo.



Senior Portrait Requirements

- Traditional head and shoulder pose
- Student should be facing the camera and sitting upright
- No hats or props allowed



Senior Personality Photo Guidelines

- Photo should show your true self
- Professional or candid shots allowed
- Black and white or color photos are acceptable
- Images should be clear and not too dark or too light
- If a picture is taken with an animal or pet, please take the photo so that the heads are side by side
- No suggestive or inappropriate photos
- Photo must follow student handbook policies and pass administrative approval.
