As a senior at Exeter High School you have the opportunity to submit a write-up that will be printed with your portrait and personality pictures in your senior yearbook. Your write-up should contain fond memories, best wishes, and thanks to family, friends and teachers. Have fun writing your final farewell to EHS!

SENIOR WRITE-UP CONSIDERATIONS

- **Think before you write.** Your yearbook write-up will last forever, so make your statement reflect those positive moments that you want to remember in years to come.
- **Proofread your write-up.** The yearbook staff only edits for inappropriateness; **we do not** correct grammar or spelling mistakes.
- **Avoid codes or suggestive phrases** which might be taken to mean something derogatory, or against school rules. Think carefully about your writing.
- **Avoid negative comments** about school, parents, faculty or students.
- **All quotes must be attributed to the author.** If you include a quote in your write up, you must show ownership. Quotes without attribution will be deleted. If the author is unknown, please indicate.
- **Use standard format** - Do not run words together. Do not use all capital letters, symbols, or bold type.
- **Word Limit** - Your entire write-up must be **75 words or less**. Your name and nickname are not counted toward the 75-word limit.
